to me paid by the said Dakyna B. Storen and R. L. Gray, Jr.

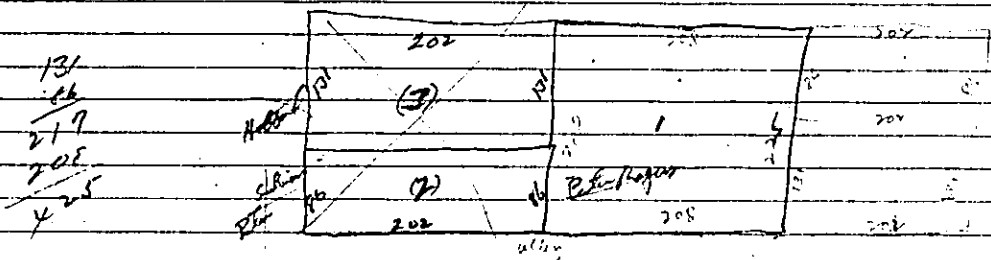
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto
