Greenville County, South Carolina, being known and
designated as Lot no. 50 of H. B. Bates property, as
shown on plat of said property recorded in the
office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Plat
Book F at page 32, fronting on the northeast side
of Bates Street, 50 feet and running back in parallel
lines 150 feet.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land lying
in Greenville County, South Carolina, being known
and designated as Lot no. 15 of H. B. Bates property,
as shown on plat of said property recorded in
the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in
