WHEREAS, South Carolina National Bank of Charleston, a Corporation

on or about the 31st day of October in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty exhibited its complaint in the Court of Common Pleas for the County aforesaid, against G. F. Bostwick, et al

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 19th day of December 1930, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

NOW, therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, That I, E. Inman Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Fifty (50.00) Dollars, to me paid by the said C. H. Martin

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said

C. H. Martin the following described real estate: All that certain tract of land in Paris Mountain Township, County and State aforesaid, containing 13.5 acres, more or less, being a portion of the Warren B. Hunt place on Saluda River, known as Lot no. 1 on plat by B. M. James, Engineer, dated May 31, 1920, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a point on Saluda River and running thence N. 76.30 E. 130 feet to corner of Lot no. 2; thence with line of Lot no. 2, S. 13.30 E. 42.60 feet to corner of Lot no. 2, thence leaving Lot no. 2 and running thence S. 76.30 W. to a point on Saluda River; thence following the meanderings of the river to the beginning course."
