the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto

N. L. Linn, his heirs and assigns forever, the following
described real estate:

We that certain tract of land in Greenville
County, South Carolina, described as follows: Beginning
at a stake 3 1/2 on the south side of a road leading
into Mountain Creek about 14 miles above Green
ville Court House and on Alvin's line, and running
thence with Alvin's line N. 42. 45 N. 5. 70 Chains
to a small gulch 3 1/2; thence N. 17. 30. 71. 4. 5. 2
Chains to a pole 3 1/2 in small branch; thence
down the meanders of said branch to Wood's Creek,
thence down the meanders of Wood's Creek to
