KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the Federal Land Bank of Columbia, a corporation created, organized and existing under and by virtue of an Act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "The Federal Farm Loan Act," for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred Sixty Six (\$ 266.00) Dollars and no cents to it well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents and the further sum of Eleven Hundred Thirty Four (\$ 1134.00) Dollars and no cents secured to be paid by Ansel Blakely of the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid, hereinafter called parties of the second part, whether one or more, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Ansel Blakely

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, lying and being situated in Grove Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, containing Ninety (90) acres, more or less, and bounded now or formerly on the north by lands of Nesbitt Estate and C. W. Mitchell, on the east by lands of C. W. Mitchell, on the south by Grove Creek and Mill Richardson and Mrs. J. H. Chestain and on the west by the Nesbitt lands more particularly described according to a plat made by William T. Lee, surveyor, in July, 1921, a copy of which is on file with the Federal Land Bank of Columbia, and being the same lands described in a mortgage from C. W. Paulin of the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid, hereinafter called parties of the second part, whether one or more, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said William R. Paulin

All that certain tract or parcel of land, situated, lying and being in Grove Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, bounded now or formerly as follows: on the north by lands of J. B. Wood; on the East by lands of J. R. Roberts and Henry Scott; on the south by lands of J. B. Alexander and Frank Blakely and on the West by lands of Mrs. J. M. Griffin and J. R.
