 Easement
 Received of the American Telephone and Telegraph Company of South Carolina, one and no/100 Dollars, in consideration of which I hereby grant unto said Company its associated and allied companies, their respective successors, assigns, lessees and agents, the right, privilege and authority to construct, reconstruct, operate and maintain lines of telephone and telegraph, consisting of such poles, wires, cables, conduits, guys, anchors and other fixtures and appurtenances, as the grantee may from time to time require, upon, across, over, and/or under the property which I own or in which I have any interest in the Township of Butler, County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, bounded by the lands of P. H. Harbin, A. L. Harbin and others and upon, along and/or under the roads, streets or high ways adjoining the said property, with the right to trim from time to time any trees along said lines so as to keep the wires and cables cleared at least thirty-six inches and the right to permit the attachment of and/or carry in conduit wires and cables of any other company; and with the further right to cut down and to keep cut down all trees and undergrowth within 25 feet of said pole line. The grantor for himself, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns hereby covenants that no wire line will be erected or permitted on said property which in the judgement of the grantee, its successors and assigns, will interfere with its service or endanger its lines. Said sum being received in full payments for the rights herein granted and for all wood and timber damage.

This easement gives the said Telephone and Telegraph Co. the right to cut down and keep cut down all trees and undergrowth within an area fifty feet by sixty five feet, the center line of said area being in line with the line of Telephone poles erected across the land of P. H. Harbin and extending not more than sixty five feet from the P. H. Harbin and E. P. Hudson land line. Said easement not to interfere with use of road through woods.
