Pridemore vs. Mary Rose Pridemore, et al. see Judgment Call C. 9, 1929 in office of Clerk of Court for Greenville County, South Carolina, do hereby release and forever discharge Greater Greenville Sewer District from any and all claims for damages, or any kind of claims, against said Greater Greenville Sewer District by reason of any damage or injury done, if done, past, present and future, to and property of J. B. Pridemore, Annella Pridemore, Anna P. Wilkins, Annabelle, Mary Rose Pridemore, bad Pridemore, and Albert Pridemore, by reason of the construction, operation and maintenance of the Sewer Disposal System near the property of said parties, the said Greater Greenville Sewer District, being discharged and forever released from any liability, whatsoever resulting out of the construction and past, present or future operation of said plant.

The following is a description of the premises affected by this release:

All that tract or parcel of land situated lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, (consisting of two tracts), containing ten acres and sixty acres, more or less, respectively, being the same lands described in deed from Lillie J. Morgan to J. B. Pridemore, dated August 31, 1904, recorded in Book No. 11, page 11, in the office of the C. M. C. for Greenville County.

The said J. B. Pridemore died intestate, leaving as his only heir at law and distributee his wife, J. B. Pridemore, and his children herein above named in this release.
