That I, J. Henry Hayes, of the City of Greenville
of the State of South Carolina, being indebted
to various parties in sundry amounts, and

desirous of making such provision as may be

granted, bargained, sold, assigned, transferred
and set over, and do hereby grant, bargain,
sell, assign, transfer and set over unto L.
Townes Curry of the City of Greenville in
said State, all my property both real and
personal, of every nature and kind whatsoever,
consisting of three lots hereinafter described, a
stock of goods in store room on Main Street
in the City of Greenville in said State and
in a branch store in the City of Anderson, in
said State, without any saving or reservation
of homestead or exemption in said real or
personal property, said real estate being more
particularly described as follows:

Those two certain lots situate in
Greenville Township, County of Greenville,
State of South Carolina, in a subdivision of
Dixie Heights, known as lots nos. 54 and 73, and
being two of the lots conveyed to me by the Dixie
Realty Company, Inc. by deed dated February
23, 1928, recorded in office of Register of Meane
Conveyance for Greenville County in Volume 72,
page 493.
