

Substitution of Trustee

Whereas Jones McCroskey and M. G. Love heretofore executed to H. J. Henderson, Trustee, that Deed of Trust with power of sale recorded in Book 85, page 247, of the Records of Mortgages and Deeds of Trust for Henderson County, conveying certain land therein described as security for the payment of certain notes therein described representing part of the purchase price of said land, said notes being payable to Alexander Finlay, who is still the owner and holder of same; and whereas the said H. Finlay, as Trustee, in his place, and ratify, approve and confirm the said conveyance by the said H. J. Henderson, Trustee, to the said Ora L. Finlay.
