Know all men by these presents, that the City of Greenville, South Carolina, a municipal corporation duly created and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of South Carolina, and the Board of Commissioners of Public Works of the City of Greenville, South Carolina, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand Eight Hundred & 80/100 Dollars (\$2800.80) to them in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the Southern Power Company, a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of New Jersey, the receipt whereof is hereby

acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, release and deliver unto the said Southern Power Company, its successors, and assigns, all that certain electric transmission line extending from the point of connection with the transmission line of the Southern Power Company, near Camp Sevier, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, to the pumping plant of the said City of Greenville, on the Enoree River, a distance of five and one-tenth (5.1) miles, more or less, together with all poles, wires, cross arms, insulators, apparatus, appliances, fixtures and material connected therewith, and all rights of way necessary for the operation and maintenance of said transmission line, together with the right at all times to enter upon the premises whereon said line is constructed, for the purpose of inspecting said line and making the necessary repairs and alterations thereon, and extensions thereof and additions thereto, together with the right to cut away and keep clear of said line all trees, and other obstructions that may in any way endanger the proper operation of the same.

Also all that certain substation of the City of Greenville, situated at or near its pumping plant on said Enoree River, together with all machinery, apparatus, appliances, equipment, transformers, fixtures and material connected therewith, incident thereto or useful therein.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to said transmission line and substation belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining.

To have and to hold all and singular the said transmission line, substation, rights, privileges and easements before mentioned unto the said Southern Power Company, its successors and assigns forever.

And the said City of Greenville does hereby bind itself, its successors and assigns, and the said Board of Commissioners of Public Works of the City of Greenville, does hereby bind itself, its successors and assigns, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said transmission line, substation, rights, privileges, and easements unto the said Southern Power Company, its successors and assigns, against the City of Greenville, its successors and assigns, and against the said Board of Commissioners of Public Works of the City of Greenville, its successors and assigns, and against all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.

In witness whereof, the said City of Greenville has caused these presents to signed in its name and behalf by its Mayor, its corporate seal to be hereunto affixed, and to be attested by its City Clerk, and also by the Board of Commissioners of Public Works of the City of Greenville this 14th day of June, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighteen, and in the one hundred and forty-second year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.
