Roberts, of Dec. 15, 1879, bounded as follows: Beginning on a pine tree at 370; thence N. 21 1/4 E. 120.00 to a rock 371; thence N. 11 W. 24.30 to a rock 372; thence S. 16 1/4 W. 24.30 to a pine tree 373; thence S. 79 1/2 E. 22.60 to the beginning, and thence by H.A. Hudson Sept. 24, 1873; (2) 10 acres conveyed to me by J.F. Bramlett Feb. 26, 1909, and bounded as follows: Beginning on a rock near E.P. Hudson's gun barrel; thence N. 05 8 1/2 W. 22.30 to a P.O. 374; thence S. 58 1/2 E. 24.13 to an iron pin in the road; thence along the road N. 4 E. 5.10 to the beginning; - (3) one part of a tract 40 acres conveyed to me on March 4, 1873, by Hm. D. Hudson bounded as follows: - Beginning on a rock 375 on road; thence N. 12 E. 24.58 to a rock 376; thence N. 53 1/4 S. 60 1/2 E. 21.75 to the beginning.
