unto the said SOUTHERN PUBLIC UTILITIES COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege, and easement to go in and upon the certain tract  
or lot of land situated in said County and State, bounded by lands of \_\_\_\_\_

in the state aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar  
and other valuable considerations to me in hand paid by the Southern Public Utilities  
Company a corporation in the state aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have  
granted, bargained, sold and released unto the said southern Public utilities Company, a  
corporation, its successors and assigns the right, privilege and easements to go into and  
upon that tract of land in the state and county aforesaid, lying along the Southern  
Railway right of way to the west of the Dunnean Mills Property

and to construct and maintain in, upon and through said premises, in proper manner with  
poles, poles to be set within five feet of property line, wires and other necessary  
apparatus and appliances, a line for the purpose of transmitting power by electricity,  
together with the right, at all times, to enter upon the said premises for the purpose of  
inspecting said lines and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon.

It is definitely understood that no towers are to be placed or erected upon this  
right of way without the further consent of the Dunnean Mills in writing.

It is further understood that upon request from Dunnean Mills the Southern Public  
Utilities Company agree to relocate, within reason, any guy wires or supports which may run  
affect of any plans which Dunnean Mills may at any future time wish to install or carry out.
