Emma A. Morrow, for and during her life,  
that is to say, her bodily heirs,  
all that piece, parcel or track of land, situated,  
lying, and being in Highland Township,  
County and State aforesaid on the public road,  
leading from Highland to Liberty Church and  
on the waters of Beaverdam Creek, consisting  
of two tracks. The first containing nearly  
190 acres more or less, less Twenty one and  
100 acres foreverly conveyed to Mrs. Hermon  
by R. L. Turner and Hermon as the Thomas  
H. Campbell land. The second track containing  
eight (8) acres more or less, and being the  
home place of the late R. L. Turner, these two  
tracks of land, are to be for the said Emma A.  
Morrow her entire life, time after which  
it shall go to her three children, namely  
Mamie Carl Morrow, Thomas Haynes, and  
Carlton Morrow. They all shall share equally  
and have equal, and can sell only to each
