(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
The Protestant Episcopal Church in South Carolina,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in the two of Greer, in the County of Greenville, and State aforesaid, on the north-east corner of Cannon and Jason Streets and being a part of the lands formerly owned by David Cannon, and conveyed by him to Louis H. Cannon, and conveyed to me, the said Hattie Cannon, and Jason Cannon by the heirs at law of Louis H. Cannon; and the said Jason Cannon having subsequently conveyed his interest to me, The said lot is shown on a plat of the estates of David and Pertina Cannon in R. M. C. Office for said County in Plat Book "F", at page 249, and is sometimes referred to as #12, as it is un-numbered on plat, but adjoins same. The lot hereby conveyed has the following metes and bounds, courses and distances: beginning at said corner of Cannon and Jason Streets, and running thence along Jason Street, S. 57-20 E. 150 feet to a road-way separating this lot from the Cemetery; thence along said road-way, N. 32-10 E. two hundred and eighteen and one-half feet to corner of said road-way and lot #12; thence W. 57-20 W. one hundred and fifty feet, more or less, to a new corner on Cannon Street; thence along Cannon Street, S. 30-23 W. two hundred and eighteen and one-half feet, more or less, to the beginning corner.

And, I, Hattie Cannon Glenn, grantor herein, do hereby declare that I am the same person to whom Jason Cannon conveyed his interest in the said lot under the name of Hattie Cannon, by his deed dated, day of and recorded in said R. M. C. Office in vol. #114, at page 305, and the same person to whom the other heirs at law conveyed their interests to Jason Cannon and Hattie Cannon, my former name, in deed of December 31, 1929, recorded insaid office in Vol. #93, at page 242.
