Hadden and Ruby Hadden:*

All our right, title and interest in and to that certain lot of land situate, lying and being on the North side of Ann Street in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, known as lot No. 3 on plat of property belonging to the Estate of Henry Campbell, deceased, made by W. C. Patton Engineer, March, 1930 and recorded in the Office of the Clerk of the County of Greenville, said lot being more particularly described on said plat as follows, to-wit:-

Beginning at an iron pin on the North side of Ann Street, corner of property belonging to Alice Hall, and running thence along inner Street N. 77-08.56 feet to an iron pin, thence N. 15-56 W. 110.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 77-13 W. 51.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 13-16 E. 110.5 feet to the beginning corner.

This deed being made pursuant to an agreement of partition, dated May 19th, 1930, and made a part of the record in the case of *Maggie Harrison, et al. vs. Thomas Hadden, Jr., et al.*, Judgment Roll No. E-1402 in the Office of the Clerk of Court of Common Pleas for Greenville County.
