that certain lot of land situate, lying and being in the
County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in Greenville
Township, near the new Mountain Road, having a front
age on Laurel Street of 50 feet, and being known and
designated as Lot No. 3 on plat of property of J. D. Omer
made by E. C. Dalton, and April 1923, and having
according to said plat the following courses and
distances, to-wit:-*

*Beginning at a point on Laurel Street, joint corner
of Lots 2 and 3, and running thence along Laurel
