(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

W. F. Wilson, the following described real estate:
All that certain tract of land situated in the County
of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on Middle Tiger
River, composed of the following three tracts:

First: Containing fifty acres more or less and in the
same tract of land conveyed by Charles E. Ford to Henry Davis,
from Henry Davis to Caroline Tinsley and Eliza Ann Jackson
jointly and by the said Caroline Tinsley Atkins, and
Eliza Ann Jackson by separate deeds to C. B. Jackson
conveying their respective half interests.

Second tract: containing seven (7) a. more or less
described as part of the old Jack Place, bought of
S. C. Dickson.

Third: Tract containing 25 acres more or less and
being the same tract of land conveyed by P. P. Verner, Master
to C. B. Jackson. The three described tracts have a total of
72 acres more or less and adjoin lands of Preston Barnett
and others, the same being the identical tract of land conveyed
by deed from C. B. Jackson to Grady O. Jackson of date Oct. 1st
1917 and recorded in Deed Book 88, Page 337, R. M. C. Office
