All that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid on headwaters of South Tyger River and has the following metes and bounds, viz. Beginning at a stone 3xom near road leading from State road to Ridge road; thence N. 13 1/2 W. 6.37 chs. to Pine 3xom; thence N. 22 1/2 W. 19.50 to stone 3xom; thence S. 27 1/2 W. 19.45 to stake 3xnm on Creek; thence down Creek to road; thence with road easterly to beginning 3x.
