(1) That lot of land situate on the West side of Augusta Street, with a frontage of 68 feet, and more particularly described in a deed from L. C. Ashmore to the grantor, dated January 1924, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County, in Volume 102, at page 20.

Subject, however, to the restrictions set forth in said deed.

(2) Those three lots of land, Nos. 8, 9 and 10, of the property of J. H. Bayne, conveyed by W. R. Timmons to the grantor by deed dated May 21, 1930, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County, in Volume 137, at page 328.

(3) Those two certain lots of land in Ward 6 of the City of Greenville, one fronting on Grove St., and the other in the rear thereof, and more particularly described in deed from J.
