All that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the county of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, on the South side of Hamilton Avenue, and being Lot 21 on plat of property of E. T. Mills, recorded in R.M.C. office for Greenville County, Plat Book "C", page 223 and being more fully described as follows: Beginning at a point on the South side of Hamilton Avenue 150 feet from the intersection of Hamilton Avenue and Calhoun Streets at corner of lot No. 20, and running thence along line of Lot No. 20 S. 16-45 N. 132.6 feet to stake; thence S. 77-45 E. 50 feet by inches to stake, corner of lot 22; thence along line Lot 22 N. 16-15 E. 135 feet to stake on Hamilton Avenue; thence along Hamilton Avenue as the line N. 73-45 W. 50 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same lot of land conveyed to me by E. T. Mills by his deed dated July 15th, 1919, recorded in Deed Book Volume 66, page 215.

2. Also all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land lying immediate to the rear of the lot described at No. 1, above and adjoining said lot and having a width of 49 feet and running back to a depth of 52 feet, which gives an additional depth of 52 feet to the lots above referred to fronting on Hamilton Avenue, and being the identical lot of land conveyed to John E. Davis, by Eliza D. Charles, by her deed dated January 16, 1923, and recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book Volume 97, page 49.
