(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Sarah W. Griffin, her heirs and assigns,
All that certain tract of land in Austin Township, in
the Town of Mauldin, Greenville County, South Carolina,
on the West side of the Main Highway from Greenville
to Laurens, having the following metes and bounds:
Beginning on the west side of the Greenville - Laurens
Highway at the intersection of the Conestee Road, and
running thence with the Conestee Road, S. 64-20 N. 19.06
chains to a bend in said road; thence continuing with
Conestee Road S. 64-10 N. 5.47 chains to a pin, corner of
Ansel King's land; thence with King's line South easterly
5.45 to a stone, corner of Cooper and King land; thence
with Cooper line S. 37.7 E. 11.50 chains (the course of this
line is taken from an old plat made by A. W. Edens, 1902)
to a corner of J. S. Cooper land; thence with J. S. Cooper's
line (according to Edens's survey) N. 82.5 E. 21.20 chains
to said highway; thence with the highway about 10.62
chains in a northerly direction to the beginning corner,
containing 29 acres, more or less.

The Grantors and grantee are the sole surviving heirs
at law and distributees of the said R. A. Whatley deceased,
who died intestate in the year 1929, owning the said
land, and this dec^d is made to partition the said
R. A. Whatley lands.

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
