All those two certain lots of land situate near the corporate limits of the City of Greenville on the south side of Laurens Road, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina and being known and designated as lots 86 and 87 on a plat of Glenn Grove Park, made by R. E. Dalton Engineer, May, 1924, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "F" at page 233, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the southwest corner of Laurens Road and McDoo Ave., and running thence along McDoo Ave., S. 15-48 N. 100 feet to a 10 foot alley, thence along line of said alley N. 73-0 W. 45.8 feet to joint corner of lots 87 and 88; thence with joint line of those lots N. 15-48 E. 100 feet to a point on Laurens Road, thence with Laurens Road S. 73-0 E. 43.6 feet to the point of beginning.

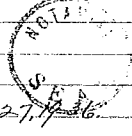

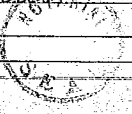
Renunciation of Dower.
