 County of Greenville }
 I, Josephine M. Carter, of the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, do hereby constitute and appoint (St. N. Johnson of Pickens County South Carolina, my agent for the following purpose, to wit: to handle for me the collection of any and all claims I may have against the Life Insurance Company of Virginia by reason of any and every policy of insurance held by me or accruing to me upon the life of Joel C. Easterburg, to act for me in its prosecution to sign any and all papers relative thereto for me and in my stead, to receive any moneys or emoluments of any kind accruing to me by reason of such claim or policy of insurance and perform any other act incident to the collection of said moneys or other emoluments, all of which I do grant and give, to my said agent and do authorize him to act in said particular in every wise and to such extent and end as fully as I might act myself.
 And I do further authorize him to receipt for me and in my stead for all such moneys received and do authorize and empower him to execute such receipt as fully binding upon me.

I do authorize the said St. N. Johnson to retain a commission of fifteen dollars (\$15.00) and all actual expense incident to collection of the said claim incurred by him. The balance shall be delivered to me, but it is expressly understood that an accounting is in no wise to affect the powers and authority of said agent with respect to third parties.

All of which authority and powers as hereinabove set out, I do hereby grant and confer upon my said agent, intending that in such matters he shall have all rights I would have, and may act in every manner and with all rights and powers I would have under the same circumstances.
