This Agreement made and entered into this 16th day of January, 1929, by and between B. E. Gur, Party of the first part, and Ethel Y. Perry, Ben Perry, Willie Mayne Perry, West M. Perry, Elizabeth F. Collins and James Y. Perry, Parties of the second part; -

Witnesseth: - that for and in consideration of the release of the Party of the first part by the Parties of the second part of this agreement to close that road designated as Paris Mountain Avenue in subdivision of the old Fair Ground Property in that section known as Sans. Lane under a certain contract heretofore entered into between the parties hereto, the party of the first part does hereby covenant and agree to permit the parties of the second part to connect with his water and sewer systems in his said subdivision free of cost for the development of their adjoining property provided that said water and sewer systems are of sufficient capacity to adequately handle such additional connections, it being expressly understood between the parties hereto that such connections shall be dependent and limited to the capacity of said sewer and water system over and above the facilities required for the development of the subdivision of the Party of the first part.

The Parties of the second part covenant and agree that in case said connections are made that they will contribute their pro rata share to the cost of keeping in repair the main line of sewer pipes through which the sewerage from their property flows.
