Know all men by these presents:

I, reposing special trust and confidence in your ability, care, prudence and integrity, have commissioned, constituted and appointed, and by these presents do commission, constitute and appoint you the said Mr. L. C. Stone, Member of the North State Water and Sewer Sub-District Committee, Greenville County in the State aforesaid, to have, hold, exercise and enjoy the said office of Member of Committee aforesaid, together with all the rights, privileges, profits and emoluments whatsoever thereunder belonging, as in any wise appertaining.

This Committee is to continue in force for the term provided by law. (two years)
