I, regarding special trust and confidence in your ability, care, judgment and integrity, have commissioned, constituted and appointed, and by these presents do commission, constitute and appoint you the said W. C. Stewart, Member North State Water and Sewer Sub. District Committee of Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, to have, hold, exercise and enjoy the said office of Member of Committee aforesaid, together with all the rights, privileges, profits and emoluments whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining.

This Commission is to continue in force for the term provided by law. (Six years)

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State, in Columbia, this first day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and thirty one and the one hundred and fifty fifth year of the Independence of the United States of America.
