I, reposing special trust and confidence in your ability, care, prudence and integrity, have commissioned, constituted and appointed, and by these presents do commission, constitute, and appoint you the said J. W. Burnett, Member of the Augusta Road Water and Sewer Sub-District Committee of Greenville County in the State aforesaid, to have, hold, exercise and enjoy the said office of Member of Committee aforesaid, together with all the rights, privileges, profits and emoluments whatsoever thereunto belonging, as in any laws appertaining.

This Commission is to continue in force for the term provided by law. (Five years)

Given under my hand and seal of the State, in Columbia, the first day of April, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and thirty-one and the one hundred and fifty-fifth year of the Independence of the United States of America.
