KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That South Carolina National Bank, a Corporation,

W. W. Parrish and J. C. Yower, their heirs and assigns forever:
All that piece, parcel or part of land, lying and being on the west side of Clayton Street, near the city of Greenville, in Greenville Township, County and State aforesaid, known and designated as lot No. 63 as shown on plat recorded in Plat Book 7, Page 127, R. M. C. office for Greenville County and having the following Metes and Bounds:
Beginning at an iron stake on north side of Clayton Street joint corner of Lots Nos. 62 and 63, and running thence N. 51-30 W. 150 feet to an iron stake; thence S. 58-30 W. 50 feet to an iron stake; thence S. 31-30 E. 150 feet to an iron stake on Clayton Street; thence N. 58-30 E. 50 feet along Clayton Street to the beginning corner.

All that piece, parcel or part of land, lying and being near the city of Greenville, in Greenville Township, County and State aforesaid and being part of Lot No. 60 as shown on plat of the estate of J. W. Army, recorded in plat Book 7, Page 127, R. M. C. office for Greenville County, and having the following Metes and Bounds: -

Beginning at a point 27.2 feet from joint corner of Lots Nos. 60, 62, 56, 57 running S. 58-30 W. 28.2 feet to an iron pin joint corner of Lots Nos. 60, 62, 56 and 57 and thence S. 34-30 E. 54.3 feet to a point on back line of Lot No. 60; thence north easterly line of new right-of-way of Highway No. 25 to the beginning corner.
