All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land lying in Chickasaw Springs  
Township and in the State and County aforesaid, and being  
known as Lot #5 of a subdivision of the John T. Taylor property  
and being on the North side of the National Highway, adjoining  
lands of W. W. Burgess, J. P. Taylor, and others; being a tract  
of land conveyed to me by R. B. Taylor and having the following  
metes and bounds: Beginning at a Gum Tree on W. W. Burgess'  
corner and running thence N. 56.45 W. 466 to a stone; thence  
N. 79.25 W. 339 to a stone in Appalachian Road; thence N. 0.30  
320 to a bend in road; thence along said road N. 7.0 W. 211  
to a bend in road; thence N. 24.0 E. 283 to a stone in the  
center of road; thence S. 88.20 E. 1540 to a stone; thence S. 33.0 W.  
along W. W. Burgess' line 1168 to the beginning, containing 20.72/100  
Acres more or less.
