(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Henry P. McGee, and his heirs and assigns, forever,  
All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township,  
Greenville County, State of South Carolina, situate, lying  
and being on Hampton Avenue Extension and on Western side  
of right of way of Southern Railway Company, near the One-  
head Bridge, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:  
Beginning at an iron pin on corner of the North side of  
public road and running thence S. 73 1/4 E. 89.5 feet to iron pin  
thence N. 19 E. 80 feet to iron pin; thence N. 73 3/4 W. 89.5 feet to iron  
pin on the East side of a road; thence with East line of the road  
S. 19 W. 80 feet to the beginning corner.
