

having been exercised unless Lessee gives Lessor notice in writing at least thirty days prior to the expiration of the period then in effect of its intention not to exercise such renewal privilege.

9. Lessee has and is hereby given the right to cancel this lease at any time on giving Lessor thirty days notice of Lessee's intention so to do.

10. Any notice to be given by Lessee or Lessor shall be sufficiently given if in writing and delivered to Lessor or mailed, postage prepaid, to Lessor at the premises herein described or at such other address as may at any time be furnished by Lessee to Lessee.
