HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said

City of Greenville, South Carolina,  
all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Town-  
ship, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, just inside  
the City Limits of the City of Greenville, S.C. on the Eastern  
side of M<sup>r</sup>. Daniel Avenue and being a street 49.8 feet in  
width and extending in parallel lines, running S. 68-16 E.  
to the City limits a distance of approximately 250 feet. This  
is so much of said street as is within the City limits  
of the City of Greenville, S.C. as is shown on Plat of the  
J. T. Jenkinson property, which Plat is recorded in Plat  
Book "A" Page 207, R. M. No. office for Greenville County.
