Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree. and upon receipt of \$292.00

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said

Andrew Moseley and his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situated in Chick Springs Township,  
County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina, and in the Town of Taylors, and being  
known and designated as Lot No. 26 on a Subdivision of Lot No. 2, property of W. M.  
Shockley, Deceased, as shown by Subdivision and Plat of same made by Thos. T. Linder, Nov.  
10, 1921, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for the County and State aforesaid, in Plat  
Book "F", at Page 20. This lot contains 2.92 acres, and is more particular described as  
follows: Beginning at the south east corner of Lot No. 25, at or near the Public Road,  
and running thence along the line of Lot No. 25, N. 77 W. 5.70 to pine; thence S. 2 1/2 E.  
5.00 to stake at corner of lot No. 27; thence S. 60 1/2 E. 5.45; thence N. 6 1/2 E. 6.35 to the  
beginning corner."
