Whereas, W. A. Forrester, J. R. Forrester, W. B. Forrester,

Mirtle L. Garrett, Olive S. Brissey, J. D. Forrester, Jessie E. Forrester, Robert Oscar Forrester and James Ellis Forrester

on or about the 15th day of June in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty three exhibited their complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Sallie F. Bramlett, Mrs Ella

Forrester, Grover C. Forrester and George W. Forrester

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 7th day of September 1933, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was

adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. Luman

Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Sallie F. Bramlett

for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No. ✓)

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. Luman

Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree.

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said Sallie F. Bramlett

all the right, title and interest of the minor Defendants, Grover C. Forrester and George W. Forrester in and to the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Austin Township, County and State aforesaid, and fully described as follows:

Beginning at a stone on R. E. Griffins line, near the G. & W. Ry. and running thence N. 15-25 E. 1250 ft. to a stone, thence S. 60-30 E. 2145 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 59 E. 421 ft. to an iron pin, thence S. 17-42 W. 881 ft to an iron pin; thence N. 68-39 W. 2483 ft to the beginning corner, and containing 61 acres, more or less.

Said land being known as Lot 201 in the division of the Estate of Isaac B. Forrester, deceased, as shown by a plat of survey made by W. J. Riddle (March) 1, 1926, and being the same land conveyed to J. D. Forrester by J. B. Forrester by deed dated March 6, 1926, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 86, page 196.

Upon the condition, however, that Mrs Ella B. Forrester is to be allowed to reside upon the premises during the term of natural life.
