demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 18th
day of September 1933, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was
adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. Inman
Master in and for the County aforesaid, to P. G. Jones and C. J. Jones,

Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree. and upon receipt of \$950.00

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said P. G. Jones and C. J. Jones

"All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land being and lying in the State and
County aforesaid, on the North side of Main Street in Fountain Inn, S. C., bounded by
lot of T. E. Jones, Mrs. Harry Starnes, being 33-1/3 feet wide on Main Street and running
back 150 feet to an alley; this being the same lot deeded to Weldon Holland by R. B.
Holland, December 11, 1915, and recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville
County, December 9, 1918, Vol 44, Page 290. Being the same tract of land deeded to
G. E. Chamblee by E. Inman, Master by deed dated June 6, 1927, and recorded in the office
of R. M. C. for Greenville County in Book 139, Page 46."
