HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said

W. P. Aiken,

"All that certain piece, parcel and tract of land situate, lying and being in
Gantt Township, County and State aforesaid, containing 31.60 acres, more or less,
according to a survey and plat made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, October 17, 1933, and
having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances, as shown by said
plat, to-wit:---

Beginning at an iron pin at the southeastern corner of said tract and running
along the line of T. F. Trammell N. 45 E. 32.00 chains to an iron pin; thence along
