"All those certain pieces, parcels and tracts of land situate, lying and being  
on the Pelham Road in the County and State aforesaid, and being known and designated as  
Tracts Nos. 3 and 5 of the V. Perry Hudson land as shown on plat made by Dalton & Neves,  
November, 1928, and having the following metes and bounds, according to said plat, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the Pelham Road corner of Tract No. 2 and running  
thence with line of Tract No. 2, N. 8-48 E. 1666 feet to a pipe, corner of Tract No. 4;  
thence with the line of Tract No. 4, N. 81-12 W. 1316.5 feet to an iron pipe corner of  
tract No. 6; thence with line of Tract No. 6, N. 75-30 W. 839 feet to a stone on E. P.  
Hudson's land; thence with his line, S. 85-52 W. 553 feet to an iron pipe; thence with  
E. P. Hudson and T. B. Jones' land, S. 6-00 E. 2108 feet to an iron pin on the Pelham  
Road; thence with the Pelham Road, N. 87-58 E. 2195 feet to the beginning corner. Tract
