Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, and upon receipt of \$2000.00
HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said J. A. Barry

"All the undivided one-half interest of Annie Belle Chamblee, Agnes Chamblee Cooper, Eddie Grace Chamblee Woods, Manning Wilson Chamblee, Pearl Elizabeth Chamblee, William Marshall Chamblee, and Minnie Belle Chamblee, heirs at law of H. E. Chamblee, deceased, in and to the following described real estate:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate at the north eastern corner of the intersection of Main Street and Fairview Street in the Town of Fountain Inn, S. C. commencing on the corner of Main and Fairview Streets and running thence S. 38 E. with Main Street thirty-three feet and four inches; thence N. 52 E. one hundred three feet; thence N. 38 W. thirty-three feet and four inches to Fairview Street and thence S. 52 W. one hundred three feet following Fairview Street to the beginning corner. Said lot being lot No. 14 in the Plan of the Town of Fountain Inn, S. C., as surveyed by J. A. Williams in 1885. This is a part of the property conveyed to W. M. Chamblee and B. E.
