S. 17 1/2 E. 11.00, to corner in spring; thence S. 21 E. 41.30  
across Simpsonville Road to stone; thence S. 65 1/2 E.  
26.65 to stone; thence S. 53 1/4 W. to middle of  
Horsepen Creek; thence down bank to point where  
two creeks run together; thence up Gleders Creek,  
crossing the Simpsonville Road to stone; thence S.
