Whereas, Mrs. J. A. Forrester, J. E. Henderson, Mrs. W. R. Golightly, Mrs. O. H. Bagwell, Mrs. J. P. McKinney, J. C. Henderson, J. D. Henderson, G. Paul Henderson, Mrs. D. C. Taylor, Mrs. Willie Springfield, Mrs. Nellie Sauls, Fred Styles, Hugh Styles, and J. T. Styles by their Guardian ad Litem Oscar Hodges

on or about the 9th day of October in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty five exhibited their complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against O. H. Bagwell, as administrator G. T. A. of the estate of Mrs. R. C. Henderson, deceased, and W. A. Smith,

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 10th day of December 1935 and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. Inman

Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Mrs. Georgia C. Smith for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No. E-5421)

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. Inman, Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, and upon receipt of \$3200.00

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said Mrs. Georgia C. Smith, her heirs and assigns forever, the following described real

estate:

"All that tract of land in County and State aforesaid on Peters Creek, waters of Rocky Creek, waters of Enoree River and known as part of the David Vaughan place containing 69½ acres, more or less.

Beginning at Maple 3 XOM on Peters Creek, thence N. 19½ E. 19.50 to stone; thence S. 54. E. 18.50 to stone; thence N. ½ E. 20.83 to stone; thence N. 32½ W. 19.35 to stone; thence S. 44¾ W. 11.00 to stone; thence S. 26 W. 11.85 to stone; thence S. 39½ W. 9.00 to stone; thence S. 44 W. 3.70 to stone in mouth of branch and on Peters Creek; thence down meandering on said creek 20.00 to the beginning corner. Said premises being the same conveyed to John T. Henderson and Mrs. R. C. Henderson by S. Elizabeth Montgomery by deed dated Nov. 1, 1904, recorded in R. M. C.
