HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said E. M. Bishop

"All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land sit-
uate, lying and being on the south side of Paris
Mountain, in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, containing 35 acres, more
or less, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

thence S. 36 3/4 E. 4.95 to a stake; thence S. 80 E. 5.50 to a stake;
thence S. 65 E. 5.00 to a stone; thence N. 41 3/4 E. 15.00 to a stone;
thence S. 84 1/4 W. 5.50 to stone; thence N. 71 1/2 E. 8.50 to a stone;
thence N. 40 E. 10.10 to stone; thence N. 48 1/4 W. 3.50 to a stone;
