All the right, title and interest of the defendants Kirven Lee Henderson, Anne Lois
Henderson, Edna Mae Henderson and J. C. Henderson Jr. in and to all that piece
parcel or tract of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina
near the Scuffletown Road, being known and designated as Tract No. 4 of the property of
J. W. Norwood according to a plat made by W. J. Riddle, March 6. 1936 and having the
following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on a fifteen foot radi, corner of tract No. 3 and running
