TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

I, E. Snman
Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GRANT
Whereas, Gertrude H. Cagle,

on or about the 24th day of June in the year of
our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty-seven exhibited her complaint in the
Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid,

Katherine Cagle, et al,

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: the case being at issue, came on to be heard on the 15th
day of July 1937 and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was
adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. Snman
Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Gertrude H. Cagle
for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No. E. 6523)

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. Snman
Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the said decree, (and upon receipt of \$1000.00)
HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said Gertrude H. Cagle.

"All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville
Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, known as Lot
No. 60, on plat of lands of said corporation (Pride and Patton
Land Company), made by R. C. Dalton, Engineer, and recorded
in R. M. C. Office for said County, in Plat Book C, page 249,
and having the following courses and distances according
to said plat:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northeast side of
Heatherly Drive 150 feet west of Valley Street, corner of Lot No.
59, and running thence with line of said lot N. 36.15
E. 150.1 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 69; thence
with the line of said lot N. 59.23 W. 50.24 feet to an iron
pin; corner of Lot No. 61; thence with line of said lot S. 36.15
W. 145.2 feet to iron pin on Heatherly Drive; thence with
Heatherly Drive S. 53.45 E. 50 feet to the beginning. Being the
same lot of land conveyed to Lee H. Cagle by Pride and
Patton Land Co., see R. M. C. deed book 72 page 37."
