All that piece, parcel or tract of land situate lying and being in Fairview Township, County and State aforesaid and more fully described by a plat of survey made by St. R. Glade on Oct. 26th 1920 and known as a part of the John Whites land, and having the following courses and distances according to said plat.

Beginning at an iron pin in the road at E. F. Griffine corner and running along the road S. 0-30 E. 9.27 to an iron pin; thence S. 8-45 E. 8.06 to an iron pin; thence west on a line 21.68 to an iron pin on Threast's line; thence N. 5-30 E. 10.92 to a post oak; thence N. 49-30 E. 13.20 to stake; thence S. 76-30 E. 9.63 to the beginning course, and containing thirty-three and thirty one hundredths acres, more or less, and being composed of the different tracts of land as follows.

All the land conveyed in the deed of J. L. Henderson to John Whites dated Jan 3rd 1920, and recorded in office of R. M. C. for said County in Vol 55 at page 206. Also the same tract conveyed by deed of Thos. L. Henderson dated Jan 19th 1918 and recorded in office of R. M. C. for said County in Vol 44 at page 206.

And a part of the same conveyed to John Whites by deed of Trustees of Simpsonville School Dist and recorded in said R. M. C. office in Vol 156 at page 16.

Also a part of the same tract containing fifty-six acres conveyed to John Whites by deed of W. J. Cox dated Jan 6th 1911 and recorded in office of R. M. C. for said County in Vol 9 at page 383.
