All that certain tract of land situated, being and lying in the State and County aforesaid and Franklin Township containing (50 5/8) fifty six and five eighths acres, more or less, being on the Tumbling Shoals Road and having the following Metes and Bounds beginning at a stone 34 NW cor. public road at corner of Mrs. Lou Latimer land and running thence N. 64 1/2 E. 39.40 to stake 34; thence N. 39 1/2 W. 18.40 to stake 34; thence S. 64 1/2 W. 6.21 to stone on branch; thence S. 53 1/2 W. 38.00 to stone on public road; thence S. 11 1/2 E. 14.10 to the beginning corner, being known as tract No. 5 in the survey of the County of J.
