(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

S. L. Coleman, his heirs and assigns, forever the following  
described real estate:

Our one fourth ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) each undivided interest in all that certain piece, parcel  
or lot of land, lying being and situate near the town of Fountain Inn, Fairview township,  
county and state aforesaid, containing three and one half ( $3\frac{1}{2}$ ) acres, more or less, bound-  
ed on the north by lot of Ben Gault, on the east by C. & W. C. Railroad, one the south  
by Nash Street, and on the West by lot of L. M. Nash, this being the same lot of land  
conveyed to W.T. Coleman, S. L. Coleman, Mary Thomason and Sallie Wham by W. T. Coleman  
individually and as executor of the last will and testament of Robert Coleman, deceased;  
S. L. Coleman individually and as executor of the last will and testament of Robert  
Coleman, deceased, and Mary I. Coleman, Mary Thomason, D. A. Coleman and Sallie J. Wham  
individually, said deed dated the 15th day of April, in the year of our Lord one thousand  
nine hundred twenty one, and in the one hundred forty fifth year of the sovereignty and  
independence of the United States of America, said deed being recorded in the R. M. C.  
office for Greenville County in deed book 61, at page 194.

The above tract or lot of land embraces and includes all of the same lots of

to Robert Coleman, recorded in Deed Book 46, at page 62, and Deed Book 46, at page 63,  
in the R. M. C. office for Laurens County; also Deed of J. Y. Taylor & C. P. Armstrong  
to Robert Coleman said deed being recorded in the R. M. C. office for Laurens County  
in Deed 53 at page 483, reference being made to said deeds for a better description.

The above described lot of land is a part of the subdivision of a tract of land which  
lies on both sides of the Greenville & Laurens County Line and deeds to same have  
formerly been recorded in Laurens County. This particular portion of said subdivision is  
situated and lies on the Greenville County side; thence this deed is made for record  
in Greenville County.
