(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Lucy L. Hindman, and her heirs and assigns forever;

"All those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville and in Greenville Township, and being known and designated as Lots Nos. 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 32, 33, 37, 38, 40, 41, 42 and 43 of the property of B. E. Geer, as shown by plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book G, page 237, and being all but three of the lots conveyed to me by the Blue Ridge Lumber Company by deed dated April 15, 1931, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 154, page 93.

"Also all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Greenville Township, and being known and designated as Lot No. 22 on plat of the property of B. E. Geer, as recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book G, page 237, and being the same lot conveyed to me by Wyatt Aiken, Trustee, by deed dated April 15, 1931, and being recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 156, at page 112."

"It is the intention also of this deed to convey all my interest in a certain strip of land that runs across the rear of lots 32-43 inclusive, except said interest heretofore conveyed in lots 34, 35 and 36, which said strip of land was formerly left for a street, which street was re-located, and is now known as Rogers Avenue."
