in consideration of the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars, in the State aforesaid  
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by  
Mrs. J. M. Trogdon,

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold, and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said  
Mrs. J. M. Trogdon, her heirs and assigns forever;

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land lying and being situate in  
the State and County above named in Graceland Cemetery, same being a part of lot No.  
368, Section 8, and containing a lot of eight feet by ten feet, same being on the  
southwest corner of the lot above referred to. Beginning on the southwest corner and  
running back North ten feet, thence East eight feet, thence South ten feet, thence West  
eight feet, fronting on a six foot walk. This being a part of a certain lot deeded to  
John Hunt by Greenville Cemetery Association by his deed dated the 7th day of July,  
1917, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County on the 28th day of June,  
1922, in Vol. 8, page 218. The lot herein deeded is eight feet by ten feet.

This conveyance is made subject to the rules and regulations of the Greenville  
Cemetery Association and the provisions set out in the deed from the Greenville Cemetery  
Association to John Hunt are hereby incorporated in this deed and made a part thereof."

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said Mrs. J. M. Trogdon, her  
heirs and assigns, forever

AND I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and  
forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said Mrs. J. M. Trogdon, her

heirs, and assigns against me and my heirs, and against  
every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.

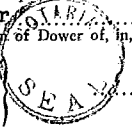
