(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
Anna Poole, and her heirs and assigns forever,

All my right, title and undivided interest, both at Law and in Equity, of in
and to all those two (2) tracts of land, adjoining each other, and together containing
Thirty-three and one-quarter (33 $\frac{1}{4}$) acres, more or less, situate, lying and being in
the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Bates Township, near Bellview,
on waters of Enoree River, near Tubbs Mountain, adjoining lands of Milup Poole, and
others. The above two (2) tracts of land are the same willed to me by my husband
Harry Poole, by his Will dated February 21st., 1924, and Filed in the Judge of Probate
for Greenville County, South Carolina, In Apartment 276, File #9, to which reference
is hereby made.
