P. E. Freeman, his heirs and assigns for ever.

All that certain piece, parcel, or tract of land lying and being situate in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Greenville Township, containing twelve acres, more or less, and adjoining land on north with lands of A. W. Jones; lands of M. G. Jones on the East; lands of the Estate of J. E. Jones on South and on the West Bynum Estate, the center of the Franklin Road being the line on the South side and the center of the White Horse Road on the West side; and having the following courses and distances; Beginning at the forks of the White Horse and Franklin Roads, thence N. 51 East 19.00 to I. P.; thence N. 39 West 8.67 to I. P.; thence South 39½ west 15.57 to the center of White Horse Road; thence said road south 5½ east 6.70 to the beginning corner as shown by plat made by W. A. Hester, Surveyor, February 7, 1928.

This deed conveys nine (9) acres more or less, of the above described property; three (3) acres, out of this 12 acre tract having been previously conveyed by me to S. B. Jones.
